By partnering with business, utilities, and government, the BLAEDC Unified Fund brings enhanced economic development opportunities to entrepreneurs and businesses in Crow Wing County.



BLAEDC's vision to assemble various funding resources into a BLAEDC Unified Fund that coordinates marketing and management processes to streamline access to financing for businesses in our area has become a reality! Nearly a dozen utilities and government funding sources were pooled to create this Unified Fund. The total amount of money is nearly \$2.5 million dollars. Current partners with BLAEDC include: City of Brainerd, City of Baxter, Crow Wing County, Crow Wing County HRA, Consolidated Telecommunications Company, City of Crosslake, and Crow Wing Power.
